

Sponsorship For Diploma In Physiotherapy / Occupational Therapy

St Luke's Hospital is a 185-bedded community hospital set up in March 1996 by 8 Christian organisations. The Hospital provides a one-stop rehabilitation centre for inpatients, as well as outpatients and home rehabilitation. Our rehab team consists of PT, OT, ST and therapy assistants totalling around 50 staff.

We specialise in stroke, orthopaedic (total hip or knee replacement, fracture and limb amputation), and cardiopulmonary rehabilitation. Besides providing usual conventional functional rehabilitation and training, we also specialize and train our therapists to provide Constraint Induced Movement Therapy (CIMT, Certified from USA), Functional Electrical Stimulation (Certified from Hong Kong), Pre and Post CIMT programs, Body Weight Supported Treadmill Training, Community Integration, Behavioural Management and so on.



In order to provide evidence based and innovative intervention, much resource has been invested in training. Most of our therapists are certified by Neuro-Developmental Training Association (NDTA from USA). Furthermore, in the past few years; we have organized more than 10 overseas training in Canada, Australia, Hong Kong, USA and China for our therapists.

For further enhancement of our services, we are partnering a number of ongoing research projects with NUS and NCSS to bring in more rehabilitation breakthrough for our patients.

On top of this, SLH provides a very conducive work environment through a very supportive multi-disciplinary team. As a hospital specialising in rehabilitation, we are able to spend fairly good quality time with our patients compared with other acute hospitals. In SLH, each therapist is covering a ward which consists of between 20 to 29 patients with a therapy assistant (4 to 8 hrs daily). The PT and OT team works closely with the doctor in charge of each ward to make important clinical decisions. The best testament to our success can be found in 75% of our patients being able to return home after successful recovery and discharge from SLH.

We are looking for therapists who share the same vision and want to bring in hope and recovery to fight against disability for the elderly sick.

Entry Requirements

Applicants for the Diploma in Physiotherapy / Occupational Therapy should have the following minimum GCE 'A' Level results:

- General Paper (English medium) at 'AO' level (Grade 1-6) or English (EL1) at 'O' level (Grade 1-7)
- A Science subject at 'A' level (Grade A-E)
- Mathematics at 'A' level or any other 'A' level subject (Grade A-E) plus Mathematics at 'AO' level (Grade 1-6) or 'O' Elementary / Additional Mathematics (Grade 1-6)

Funding Support

St Luke's Hospital will provide the following bursary (conditions apply) for deserving and promising candidates:

Conditions of Sponsorship

Applicants must :

- Gain admission to the Diploma in Physiotherapy / Occupational Therapy at Nanyang Polytechnic (NYP)
- Pass medical examination required by NYP
- Upon graduation, the students will serve SLH for a bond period for 1-3 years as a Physiotherapist or Occupational Therapist

Application Procedures

Step 1: If you are interested in a Physiotherapy / Occupational Therapy career with St Luke's Hospital, please forward your application form to us.

Step 2: If selected, you will be notified by us to come for an interview at St Luke's Hospital. **Only** shortlisted applicants will be notified.

Step 3: Successful candidates will be required to sign a training deed with SLH. Two guarantors will be required for the signing of the deed.

Step 4: Upon successful completion of the course, you will serve a 1-3 year bond with our Hospital.
