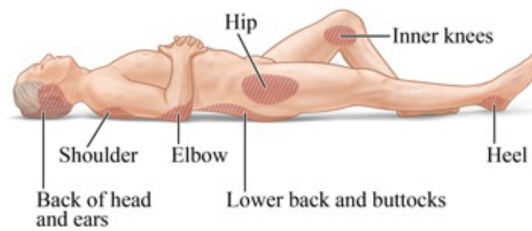
What is pressure injury?

Pressure injury is an injury to the skin and underlying tissue. It is caused by constant pressure, friction or shearing movement against the skin.
